How to get to Davos

As Davos is a small place, overbooked by the guest of January events and tourists, we checked alternative options for you.

It's possible to drive from Zurich (about 2 hours).

There is also a train from Zurich (about 2,5 hours).

The earliest one is at 6:37 am (you will arrive at Davos Platz at 8:57 am).

In order to be on time for the EmTech Investment meeting on Friday, 25 January, please leave Zurich not later than 8:07 am.

The last train from Davos Platz:

- to Zurich at 9 pm or 9:50 pm.
- to Landquart at 9:50 pm. or 11 pm.
- Chur 9:50 pm or 11 pm.

3. These might be the best options for you: stay overnight in or near Landquart (by car: 40 minutes; by train: 1.5 hours) or Chur (by car: 1 hour; by train: 1,5 hours) in affordable hotels and take the train to Davos in the morning on Friday.
